(Note: The BLS uses two monthly surveys to measure employment levels and trends – the Current Population Survey (CPS), which counts people, and the Current Employment Statistics (CES) survey, which counts jobs – and they almost never agree; the numbers below are from the more accurate CPS.)

“Total nonfarm payroll employment rose by 266,000 in November, and the unemployment rate was little changed at 3.5 percent, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics reported today. Notable job gains occurred in health care and in professional and technical services. Employment rose in manufacturing, reflecting the return of workers from a strike.” (BLS, 12-6-19)
